Dear Gov. Guiao,

This pertains to on-going efforts to formalize the creation of an entity, by way of an Institution, Commission or Foundation aimed to institutionalize EDSA or what we may call, the Spirit of EDSA. As you know I have had the distinct pleasure and honor to be invited to sit as a member of the AD-HOC Committee to help effect this objective.

During a meeting of the AD-HOC Committee which I have attended last 06Oct93 at Bahay Ugnayan, Malacañang, a concept paper was presented, which essentially covers most of the points of a position paper I submitted last 23 March 1993, concerning the proposed creation of an EDSA Commission. Since the directions of the AD-HOC Committee is basically geared towards the same principles and objectives of the SPIRIT OF EDSA FOUNDATION, INC, the undersigned, as well as, the other bonafide board trustees, in the best interest of its objectives, propose :

To turn over the already incorporated Foundation to the AD-HOC Committee for re-organization and expansion, in order to collectively work towards the successful attainment of our shared goals, rather than have two organizations working separately and defeating the very essence and meaning of the purpose we are set to achieve, particularly if we are divided. However, since our Foundation's main project was precisely to establish a Philippine Landmark that would have an EDSA Museum, an audio-visual auditorium, EDSA Heroes memorabilia, etcetera, coupled with the fact that we have long been brainstorming the concept and have certain ideas of implementations, it would be desired that the undersigned heads this committee with some of his founding trustees, together with other appropriate members.


I trust that the AD-HOC Committee would find this offer not only appealing, but opportune. Needless to say, I would be relinquishing my post as Chairman, and open the Foundation for reorganization, in the interest of the majority and the good of our common causes.

Should this proposal be acceptable to the AD HOC Committee, we would submit our incorporation papers as reference, and would, of course, have to re-organize and effect the necessary board resolutions to meet SEC requirements for the changes. Should this proposal, on the other hand, not be acceptable, then we would simply continue as a separate entity, maintaining our existing organization and programs, as well as, play a supportive role on some of your projects.
